Squidgy Sharp (don't touch!)

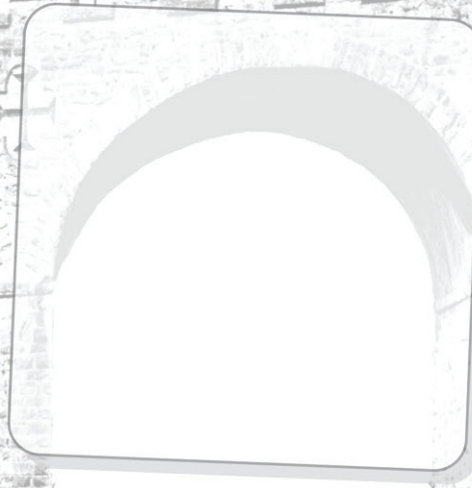
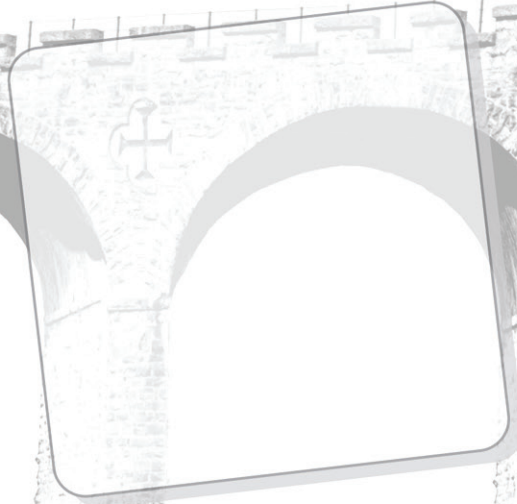
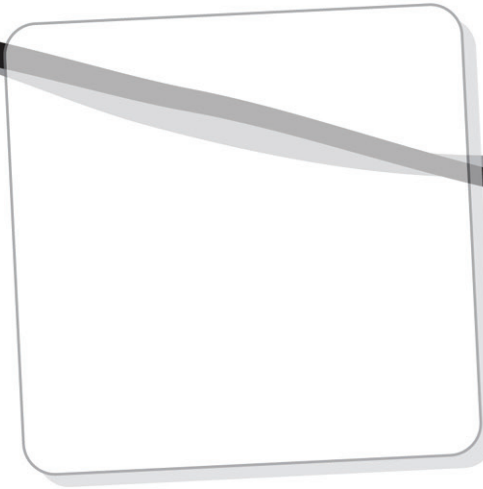
And be extra careful of things that might sting!
